





Public Speaking & Communication Skills

The course teaches children to talk meaningfully, clearly and with some expressiveness and introduces awareness of accent and articulation. The course proceeds with children developing competence in delivering a simple narrative or description from memory and introduces an early awareness of delivery to an audience. The course delivers this knowledge through increasingly difficult but always 'fun' challenges which empower our young students without them ever necessarily becoming aware of their training. The course concentrates on the use of accents and teaches received pronunciation, often described as 'The Queens English' RP equips its masters with stage presence and a higher level of elocution. Students are also given the opportunity to take annual accredited Trinity Examinations in communication skills.



- Teamwork.



- Taking measurements correctly.





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Ballet



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
Karate
