SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Aims: It is our aim that all students at DS conform to the School Uniform policy and take a pride in their appearance. It is imperative that students wear the correct uniform designated by the school management.

When: The School Uniform Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions or at sporting events where they represent the school. Students will not be permitted to attend events, trips and sporting fixtures if they are not in full uniform.

The following rules must be observed with regard to the school uniform:

- All uniforms must conform to the correct school uniform colour and pattern. Discoloured/faded and uniforms that do not conform to school standards must not be worn.
- Students must remove any jackets/hoodies/sweaters/hats etc. that are not part of the school uniform during morning registration and place them in their bags until home-time.
- Shoes must be 100% black/ White with no coloured logos and no coloured laces. Examples below.



Boys:

- Hair must be neatly combed, cut / trimmed. Length of the hair must not be below the nape of the neck. Hair colouring / dyeing is not permitted.



Girls:

- Hair must be tied neatly. Girls will not be permitted to leave their hair open if their hair is below shoulder length.
- Hair colouring/ dyeing is not permitted.
- Nails must be clean and trimmed. Coloured Nail Polish and excessive make up must not be worn.
- Very short skirts are not permitted. Uniform skirts/skorts must be not more than 1 inch above the knees.
- Earrings: For safety reasons, long earrings are not permitted. Studs and small hoops are permissible.
- Leggings/ stockings etc. are not permitted, unless they are black.
- Only plain black hijabs are permitted. No floral or coloured designs are allowed.

Secondary & Post 16

Secondary students must observe modesty, appropriateness, and neatness in clothing and personal appearance.

- **Boys** – must be clean shaven, hair neatly combed, cut/ trimmed. Length of the hair must not be below the nape of the neck. Nails must be clean and trimmed. Any tattoos must be covered and no jewellery or piercings to be visible. Secondary boys cannot have dyed hair or inappropriate hairstyles. Caps and hats cannot be worn.
- **Girls** – hair must be tied neatly. Girls will not be permitted to leave their hair open if their hair is below shoulder length. Hair colouring/ dyeing is not permitted. Nails must be clean and trimmed. Coloured Nail Polish and excessive makeup must not be worn. Any tattoos must be covered. Caps and hats cannot be worn.

Students who do not wear the correct uniform will be sent home. Once they change into their correct uniforms, they can return to school.

Students are expected to wear the authentic school uniform, whether bought at school or through an outside retailer. Failure to do so may result in your child not being offered a seat in the school for the following year.

School Management will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning the interpretation of the School Uniform code.
