Entry-Exit Policy for Year 12 & 13 Students

2025 - 2026

Dubai Scholars is giving Year 12 & 13 Students an opportunity to gain an early college experience of taking classes and leaving the premises. This will assist them in being responsible and understanding the importance of being independent and making the right choices.

Students can come in before their classes and leave once their classes are over. Students can enter and exit multiple times. They will need to follow their Individual Subject Timetables.

It is important that every student who opts for Multiple Entry/ Exit has an ID Card and shows their entry and exit time to the security. Students will not be allowed to enter without their ID.

- To obtain an ID card, students will have to pay a fee of AED 50/. This will be debited to the parent's account as soon as we receive confirmation from the parent to allow them for Entry/ Exit. However, if the parent does not consent with the Multiple entry/exits, **the ID card is mandatory.**
- Students must make sure that they are on the school premises before their class time, lateness and absence will be strictly recorded. Attendance is taken for each class by every subject teacher.

Permission to the Multiple Entry & Exit Format **will ONLY be** provided to those students whose parents have no objection to such an arrangement.

As an alternative, they are free to stay and continue being in school for group study or involved with other school activities. As an institution, we are open to both options.

We encourage parents and students to take collaborative decisions such as this, depending on whichever system they find most congenial and effective. Parents, please ensure you have a word with our children before you sign up for any of the options. Students should not misuse time and opportunity. They should keep you informed of their whereabouts.

***However, if they wish to use the Bus Transport, they will have to follow the regular school timings.**
